

Birkwood Primary School Council Meeting - Minutes
26th January 2018 at 1.30pm

1. Evie opened the meeting and thanked everyone for coming, there was a special welcome for Clare Kaye from Team Activ.
2. There were no apologies for absence.
3. **Minutes of the last meeting** ~ were discussed and agreed.
4. **Team Activ** ~ Clare explained to Councillors that she worked with other schools at lunchtimes and they provided a wide range of activities. It was up to Councillors which activities they would prefer for each year group for next half-term. Team Activ would provide all of the equipment, come into school from 12 until 1.30pm and deliver the activities. There could be class competitions and stars of the day (boy and girl). Councillors agreed that lunchtimes would be more exciting and children would get extra exercise. To begin with, it was agreed that the little ones would play circus games and have treasure hunts; Year 1 and 2 could play football; Year 3/4/5/6 tig games which they really like. Mrs Allen asked Clare to cost how much it would be to have the activities every day. Kaydee said that she thought it was all a really good idea!
5. **Head Boy and Head Girl.** Mrs Allen checked that Councillors were still interested in standing for election ~ Alfie-Joe, Kane, Joseph, Lillie Rose, Gracie, Dylan, Evie and Kaydee (4 boys and 4 girls) agreed that they would still like to, although they hadn't prepared their speeches. Mrs Allen explained that they need to be ready for the Hustings in Assembly on Monday, all agreed:

 - 'I would represent our school well because ...'
 - 'What special skills and talents I have'

Ballot forms were shared with the children; Key Stage 2 children will have the opportunity to vote and put their Ballot Forms into the Ballot Boxes which Mr Markham has kindly borrowed from the Town Hall. Results will be counted next week and announced.
