Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a wonderful start to the new academic year. We really enjoyed our WW2 topic and our trip to Eden Camp. We also enjoyed the lead up to the Christmas period and all the festivities. Mrs Porter and I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for our cards, gifts and well wishes, it was very kind and much appreciated.

We have another exciting term ahead and below is an overview of the areas we will be covering:

Literacy/History

We will be closely linking our work in literacy with our **Titanic** topic. We will begin our literacy work through researching key facts surrounding the sinking of the Titanic. Using our research as a stimulus, we are going to create a newspaper report. We will use modelled writing of newspapers to allow us to identify the key features required in our own.

Once this is completed, we are going to create instructions of how to stay safe on the Titanic. This will allow us to look at the issues faced in 1912 and what we could put in place on ships to ensure that this disaster never happened again. This will link heavily to ICT as it will be a research project.

There will also be a specific focus on the development of more spellings related to topic, punctuation and grammar.

Spellings will be given and tested on Fridays

There will also be homework provided and reading on a weekly basis.

Mathematics

We are going to begin the term with a reinforcement of previous learning relating to Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division and then move on to the recognition of Roman Numerals. After, we will work on identifying fractions and their decimal equivalents. In shape, space and measure we are going to look at the area and perimeter of regular and irregular shapes.

The children will have the opportunity to apply their learning to real life scenarios and become 'masters' of mathematics.

ICT

The children will use the internet effectively for research and select information appropriate to a given task. This will be linked very closely to literacy and topic work, giving them the chance to use our computer suite and the iPads to complete research on specific themes.

In addition, we are looking at electronic music and how we can make music using computers and iPads. This will give us the opportunity to use programs such as Isle of Tune and Garage Band to plan and create electronic music.

Art/Design Technology

The children will be working with watercolours and pastels frequently during this term. They will be using these to recreate the famous scene of the Titanic's final hour. They will also have the chance to use ICT to recreate different aspects of the boat using 3D shapes and digital paint.
