If you would like to discuss your child's homework, please call in at the end of the day.



## **Class Newsletter**

This newsletter is to keep parents informed about class news and to give a brief summary of the curriculum areas we will be covering in the coming term.

#### **Contacting Us**

# **Literacy**

Over the next term we will be covering a variety of topics such as diary writing, converting poetry into narrative, descriptive and narrative writing based on Rudyard Kipling's 'Just So' Stories.

Children will also take part in a number of literacy activities related to reading, spelling and handwriting. We will link our literacy work to our topic where possible. We will also read The Highwayman by Alfred Noyes and rewrite the poem as a narrative.

We will do lots of revision and practise ready for our SATs in May.





#### **Numeracy**

We will be studying a variety of topics over the next term including: place value, strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, 3D shapes and their nets, the mean and fractions, decimals and percentages.

Children will also be learning to apply their mathematical skills to real life problems.

We will continue to learn our multiplication and division facts and will practise arithmetic questions.

### **ICT**

Our ICT lessons will be carried out in conjunction with our topic work. We will continue to work on our app designs by becoming market researchers and interface designers.





#### **Science**

This term children will be learning about 'Evolution and Inheritance'. Children will learn how characteristics can be inherited from our parents and explore why these are useful. We will look at how living things have adapted over time to suit their environment. We will also look at the work Darwin did and discuss his impact on our understanding of evolution.

## **Evolution Revolution**

Our topic this term is all about **The Victorians**. We will be learning lots of interesting facts about the era, focussing on important historical figures.

We will learn about the significance of Queen Victoria's reign, will discuss home life for all classes of people during the period and will learn about school and work life for children.

# **RE/PCSHE**

In RE we will be learning more about Christianity and will look at Christian beliefs linked to eternity. We will use Christian weddings as a stimulus for our learning.

PCSHE will be covered through Ask It. Children will explore a range of stories, texts, pictures and videos and will discuss the themes and issues shown. Children will be encouraged to ask thoughtful questions and listen and respond to the opinions of others.
