<p><b>Rationale:</b>          The PE and Sport Grant is devolved funding from central government. This funding must be used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport for the benefit of pupils aged 5 – 11 years old in the 2017 to 18 academic year so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.          The PE and Sport Grant at Birkwood Primary School for the academic year 2017/18 is £18,920, with £11,036 being received in October (17/18 financial year) and £7,884 in April 2018 (18/19 financial year).  <i>'Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer.'</i> (Gov.UK July 2017)</p>
